

## How to configure Handbrake to create MP4 video clips for the BMW i3?




(1) Set "Anamorphic" to "None". Otherwise the playback ratio will be wrong (especially if you convert DVDs, for BluRays it does not care.)




(2) Do not change the default settings here if you convert DVDs or Blurays. If you convert a TV-recording it may be necessary to set "Deinterlace" to "Slower".




(3) Set "Average Bitrate" to 1000 kbps and activate "2-Pass Encoding". You can even go down with the "Average Bitrate" to 500 kbps. This safes space on you USB stick (but reduces quality).



(4) Select the language you need. Do not change the other settings: Codec: AAC (avcodec), Bitrate: 160, Mixdown: Dolby Pro Logic II. If you reduce the Bitrate to 128 kbps, you will hear bad noises. If you want to convert a concert with high quality sound, increase the Bitrate to 256 kbps.



(5) Do not change the default settings here. We don't need any subtitels.



(6) Do not change the default settings here. Chapter markers may be helpfull.

## Some remarks:

The result (the created MP4-File) will be compatible to many many devices. Here what I positivly tested:

- BMW i3 (built 07-2015)
- Apple iOS (iPad, iPhone, iPod touch)
- Windows Phone 8
- Playstation 3
- Playstation 4
- Windows PC using VLC (I did not try other Players)
- Apple MAC OS using VLC (I did not try other Players)

In fact I could not find any device wich did NOT accept and play the created MP4-Format.
